On account of the above, the depreciation for the nine months and quarter ended December 31, 2014 is higher by Rs.61 Lakhs and Rs. 10 Lakhs respectively. As per provision of Part C of Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 an amount of Rs. 9 Lakhs has been debited to the opening balance of the retained earnings as at April 01, 2014 towards the carrying amount of assets, where the remaining useful life of these assets is Nil.
