The Company had received a demand of service tax of Rs.3608 Lakhs and equivalent amount of penalties under the provisions of the Finance Act, 1994 along with the consequential interest, for the period from April, 2006 to July, 2009 towards service tax payable on import of certain services. The Company had filed an appeal contesting the demand before the Central Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal (CESTAT), Bangalore. During the period, CESTAT, without expressing any opinion, has remanded the appeal back to the adjudicating authority and dispensed with the requirement of pre-deposit.

During the year ended March 31, 2013, the Company had assessed the carrying value of goodwill arising from its investment in its subsidiary viz. Subex Americas Inc., amounting to Rs. 18,606 Lakhs.
